Brexit poster ready to distribute – same for all partners
New Chair for BTHFT has been identified – announcement due 18th March
First ICS Partnership Board review; went well.
Good overall CQC rating for Airedale hospital

Item 4: SPA

Version 2 is now going to boards for signature. 8 have signed and 4 remaining are just waiting for Board meetings or formation of a company. Looking for a publicity launch in next months – probably June.

Acknowledgement that SPA will develop and we do need to get on with things.

Schedules to the document will be flexible.

ICB ToR were discussed – there are some requests to remove quoracy as we are a consensus group rather than voting.

Item 5: GP Contract Reform

The concerns are:

- CPs become inward facing
- The ‘money’ seems to be not new money but moving money about again; we have to wait and see
- Concerns that some GPs practices will want to form new PCNs outside the CP structure we already have and that this will disrupt the work to date
- Need to get GP partners to see that new money is for the people in our place and use to develop opportunities with partners

Final decisions for PCN formats needs to be completed by May.

ICB and WY&H ICS are both keen that the current CP and associated footprints become the PCNs in our District. (caveat noted that the money for PCNs will have to flow elsewhere as it needs to go to a GP practice).

Item 6: Living Well

The ICB received a presentation on the Living Well Scheme (now the new name for self-care and early prevention programme).

Notes: want to build on existing work on ABCD, bring learning from self-care work delivered previously – all projects delivered under this will align to Living Well (eg Community Connectors (social prescribing)).

Would like to see an explicit mention of Mental Health in the strategy rather than implicit.

How will Social Movement be built?

Public launch from 22nd June (Dragon Boat race weekend) – prior to this there will be a comms lead-in and the Living Well team would like to engage with VCS comms leads.

Item 7: System Development (OD)

There is a system need to get our workforce supported to work in a different way but the system lacks the resources to support this. Partners are being asked to build development work into their existing resources.

For the VCS this will be different – we should have a discussion about this at ASG to decide a way forward.

Item 8: Consultation on NHS Legislation changes

Individual partners have been asked to consider responding to this consultation.
