

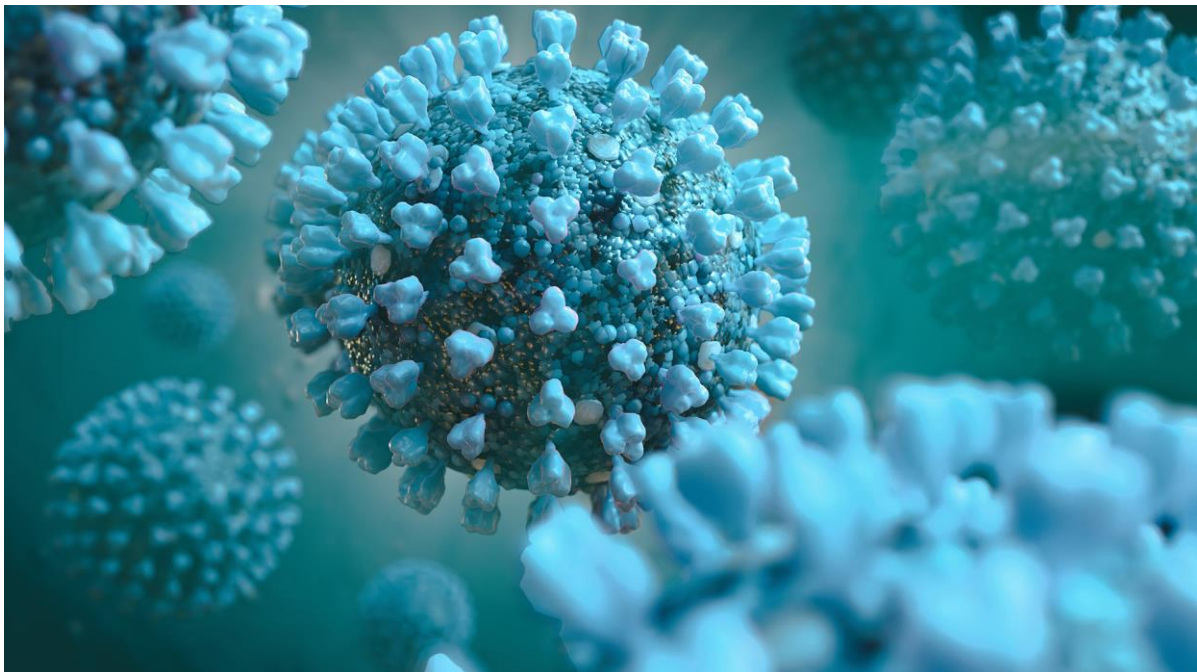
## Have you had critical illness with COVID-19?

**We are looking for volunteers who identify as Black, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Indian, Mixed or any other Minority Ethnicity to talk to a researcher (by phone or videocall) about their experiences of being critically unwell with COVID-19.**

If you are 18 years or older and received critical care (i.e. were admitted to an Intensive Care Unit or High Dependency Unit) for COVID-19 then you may be able to take part in this study.

We can use a professional interpreter if you are not fluent in English.

The findings from this study will help highlight what support is needed by people recovering from critical illness with COVID-19.
